Avaya Streamlines Its Services Credential and Certification Program

Avaya is consolidating its Credential and Certification Program into a single credential program category for Service Technicians - now named the Avaya Services Technical Associate (ASTA). Benefits to students include:

- A single platform for test delivery and online on-demand testing
- Elimination of external examination fees
- Investment protection and a simplified skill validation process for participants

Details:

- Beginning March 1, 2025, Avaya will automatically grant the specified ASTA credential (issued with no initial expiration date) to students holding a current ACIS and/or ACSS certification. Credential holders will therefore maintain their existing ACIS and/or ACSS until the expiration date reflected on their individual record as recognition of the investment made.
- As the new ASTA offerings become available, Avaya will introduce Online Tests through the Avaya Learning Center, replacing current Proctored Exams.
- Avaya's current portfolio of training will continue to be available on the Avaya Learning site: [Avaya Learning](#).
- Avaya Proctored Exams will be available at Pearson VUE Testing Services until February 28, 2025, the final day of exam registration and delivery.
